

Global and Diversity Descriptions

Diversity - The purpose of this requirement is for students to take courses that broaden their perspectives on the many views and complexities associated with diversity, and *inform their decision-making regarding diversity*. These courses discuss, study or explore cultural issues that highlight differences that occur within society. They should include such topics as religion, race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, and disability.

Globalization - A category of courses that discuss study or explore cultures, languages, history, government structures or business practices in or with countries other than your own. The most likely areas for such courses may include: Asian Studies, archeology, art history, modern languages and literature, classics, economics, global studies, history, international relations, or any non-English language.
